



Colors beginning with 20501 refer to YLI Fine Metallics, 7 refer to Yenmet Metallic, 8 refer to YLI Variations Variegated Thread and 9 refer to Isacord Multicolor Variegated.

Wallhanging Instructions

Create a quick small wallhanging showcasing OESD Quilting Feather Daisies #12521 embroidery collection. This collection features 9 different outline quilting daisy designs. Use the embroidery designs to "quilt" the wallhanging. It is simple and fun.

### **Supplies:**

- OESD embroidery collection Quilting Feather Daisies #12521
- 1 yd. fabric (front center, back and binding)
- 1/4 yd. print fabric (borders)
- <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> yd. or 24" square cotton batting
- Embroidery threads
- Temporary spray adhesive or curved safety pins
- Double sided fabric tape
- Fabric marking pen
- Walking foot

**NOTE:** The yardage allows for (9) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. If you want the squares bigger like 6", then multiply 6" x 3 = 18" +  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seams = 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square (front center). Make adjustments for the back and borders also.

#### Cut:

- (1) 17" square fabric (front center)
- (1) 24" square fabric (back)
- (2) 3 ½" x 23" print fabrics (borders)
- (2) 3 ½" x 17" print fabrics (borders)
- (2) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 44" fabric (binding)




### Prepare for embroidery: 1/4" seam allowance

- Right sides together, pin and stitch each 3 ½" x 17" borders to front center. Press seam away from front center. **Photo 1.**
- Right sides together, pin and stitch each 3 ½" x 23" borders to front center. Press seam away from front center. (Quilt top) **Photo 2.**
- Layer a quilt sandwich, by placing back wrong side up, cotton batting, and the quilt top right side up. Use temporary spray adhesive or safety pins to baste the layers together. **Photo 3.**

#### **Embroider:**

• Divide and mark the front center of the quilt top into 9 squares. Each daisy embroidery design is hooped and stitched into one of the 9 squares, starting in the center. The square daisy embroidery designs are stitched in the center and the four outer corners. The other daisy designs are stitched in the remaining four squares. There is no stabilizer because the thickness of the batting serves as a stabilizer. **Photo 4.** 





Instructions

- Starting with the center square, find and mark the center. Place double sided fabric tape on the wrong side of the inner hoop. Using template in inner hoop, position onto center mark on center square, and hoop. Place hoop on the embroidery machine and find center point. Photo 5. Stitch embroidery design. Remove hoop. Photo 6.
- Repeat the process of finding center mark, hooping, and stitching the next embroidery design until all the squares are completely stitched. **Photo 7.**

### Assembly:

- Using walking foot, stitch along straight lines that were created to divide quilt into squares. Quilt the borders as desired. **Photo 8.**
- Square up the quilt, this is trimming the quilt until the sides are equal. This prepares the quilt for stitching on the binding. **Photo 9.**
- Stitch on the binding as desired.
