Small Quilt Instructions

Graceful Gardens #80044 by Kaye England embroidery collection features 22 designs. About half of the designs are outline designs, some single colored and some multi-colored. The designs that are flowing in the breeze take you to the gardens outside a cathedral. The colors are soft yet visible from afar. A small quilt (24" square) was created using the larger flowers as the center block on point and accented with the leaf corners and leaf accent. The fabric colors were chosen from the designs themselves. Create a garden haven with these beautiful designs.

Supplies:

- OESD embroidery collection Graceful Gardens #80044 by Kaye England
- ½ yd. off-white fabric (embroidered center block)
- 1/3 yd. burgundy fabric (triangles)
- 1/4 yd. light pink fabric (inner border)
- 1 1/8 yds. green fabric (outer border and back)
- ½ yd. fabric (binding) (burgundy fabric was used in project)
- ³/₄ yd. or 26" square cotton batting
- Embroidery threads
- Heavy weight tear away stabilizer
- Temporary spray adhesive
- Double sided fabric tape
- Fabric marking pen
- Curved safety pins
- Thread for piecing

Cut:

- (1) 26" square fabric (back)
- (2) 1 ½" x 44" light pink fabric (inner border)
- (3) 3 ½" x 44" green fabric (outer border)
- (2) 2 1/4" x 44" fabric (binding)

Embroider & Assembly: 1/4" seam allowance

• The design used for the center block is "Flowers C" #80044-09. Its size is 9.21" x 7.64".

Note: Depending on your embroidery machine and maximum hoop size will determine which flower design to use. For most embroidery machines, "Flowers B" #80044-08 will work. It's size is 6.58" x 4.31". If

you happen to have a larger hoop for your machine then you could use the one we used.

- Cut the off-white fabric and 2 pieces tear away stabilizer to fit your hoop size, making sure the fabric is a larger square than needed for the center on point block with 1/4" seam allowances added.
- Using temporary spray adhesive, spray between two layers of tear away stabilizer and adhere to each other and to the wrong side of the off-white fabric piece. Hoop the layers. Embroider design. Remove from hoop and remove stabilizer. **Photo 1**






Small Quilt Instructions

- Cut the embroidered center block so that it is on point. Find the center and draw lines on the fabric before cutting to make sure the design is centered. Once you have the block centered, then cut on your drawn lines. **Photo 2.** The block size we cut is 12 ½". If you have used the smaller Flowers B then you might want to cut your block smaller. **Photo 3**
- The triangle pieces of fabric are the next to cut. Start with laying the block on point on a gridded mat, with a ruler measuring the length of a side. **Photo 4**
- The measurement for the side is 9" for our project. Therefore, a 9" square was cut and then cut into 2 triangles. Photo 5
- Right sides together, pin and stitch triangles to opposite sides of the center block. Press seam away. Right sides together, pin and stitch the remaining triangles to opposite sides of the center block. Press seam away. Trim off points to make sides even. **Photo 6 & 7**
- Measure opposite sides of the block for the inner border and cut two pink fabric strips (inner border).
 Find the center point for the fabric strips and opposite sides of the block. Right sides together, match and pin the center points. Stitch. Press seam away. Measure remaining opposite sides of the block and cut two pink fabric strips (inner border). Repeat steps above. Photo 8 & 9
- Measure opposite sides of the block for the outer border and cut two green fabric strips (outer border).
 Repeat as for the inner border above.
- The "Leaf Accent" #80044-06 was stitched in two opposite triangles. Print paper template of the design.
 Place on one of the triangles in the direction desired. Photo 10
- Mark the center point. Photo 11
- Cut two pieces of tear away stabilizer for the size of hoop needed. Using temporary spray adhesive, spray between two layers of stabilizer and adhere to each other and to the wrong side of the triangle area. Place double sided fabric tape on the wrong side of the inner hoop. Photo 12. Using template in inner hoop, position onto center mark on triangle, and hoop. Photo 13. Place hoop on embroidery machine and find center point. Embroider design. Remove from hoop and remove stabilizer. Repeat for the design on the opposite triangle.




























Small Quilt Instructions


• The "Leaf Corner" #80044-05 was stitched in two opposite corners mostly on the outer border. Print paper template of the design. Place on one of the outer border corners being sure the design does not interfere with stitching the binding. Mark the center point. **Photo 14**

• Cut two pieces of tear away stabilizer for the size of hoop needed. Using temporary spray adhesive, spray between two layers of stabilizer and adhere to each other and to the wrong side of the corner area, keeping in mind that the stabilizer may be bigger than the fabric. Place double sided fabric tape on the wrong side of the inner hoop. Using template in inner hoop, position

onto center mark on corner, and hoop. **Photo 15.** Place hoop on embroidery machine and find center point. Embroider design. Remove from hoop and remove stabilizer. Repeat for the design on the opposite corner. (Quilt top) **Photo 16**







- Layer a quilt sandwich, by placing back wrong side up, cotton batting, and the quilt top right side up. Use curved safety pins to baste the layers together. Photo 17
- Quilt as desired.
- Square up the quilt, this is trimming the quilt until the sides are equal. This prepares the quilt for stitching on the binding. Stitch on the binding as desired.
